Seed Corn

We send \$600 to Mike Kitwaka to support his request to buy seed corn. I received this picture last week. The seed corn will be planted at the Chardeleco leper community to help to provide a sustainable source for corn going forward. In the past we have bought corn that was distributed and consumed for food. This corn will both provide food and seed to plant in the next growing season. With success, we would like to expand this program the next season.



Iambi Nursing School:

We've sent funds (\$6,750) to support lambi Nursing School's preparate for certification of their 3-year degree program that included buying computing equipment, e.book program and renovation of classroom and facilities and paying the fees for certification. We also send funds to support hiring two new teachers for about 8 months. They have a new website: http://www.iambinursing.ac.tz/, and they are in the final steps of hiring two new teachers.

I received receipts for all the expenditures and the following note with summary of expenses from Principal Joyce Lyanga.

"Hello Dan, its another good day to say good morning to you all. today we want to give you a final summary of money expenditure of Tshs.17,714,000/= as follows:-

Further more, we are very grateful to receive teacher's fund for salary Tshs. 15,961,300/= may the almighty God bless you so much for your giving.

The school looks so wonderful now and in two weeks time, we hope the Ministry of Health will come to inspect the school for giving us Diploma so that we can introduce other Health programmes in the school.

lambi Lutheran Hospital Autoclave purchase and Eyecare treatments

"Habari rafiki.

We hope that this mail finds you doing well with your family, I promised you previous to find and send you that Eye programme at lambi for April, May and June 2021, and this report involved data worked in two dispensaries belong to lambi Hospital which is Isanzu and Tulya Dispensary see the Attachment, attached in this mail. Joshua Vitus Ngiliule."

The report included accounting of over \$500usd to apply prophylaxis eye treatment to 128 new born children, and nearly \$900usd to treat lepers and others in need in Nkungi village with preventative and corrective eye care last spring and summer.

Autoclave purchase:

We wired \$3,000usd to lambi Lutheran Hospital to purchase an autoclave to sterilize surgical utensils for surgery and delivering babies. This purchase will avoid sepsis in surgical patients, newborns and their mothers.
